The most wonderful time of the year.





THE REASON FOR THE SEASON

Have you ever wondered...?

Why do people get so excited about Christmas? It all started as a Christian celebration of the birth of Jesus, but now it has become a cross-cultural season of shopping and parties and gift-giving, decorating and singing and candy.

For the Christian, it's still a special day, because of who Jesus is. Jesus is our King. He is the son of God, who came to earth to save us and promise everlasting life.



God created the universe, including our world and everything in it. He made us—we're His *children*—because He wanted a family, a relationship with us based on love. But He wanted us to *choose* to want to be part of His family; He didn't want to force it. By giving us the power of choice, we made many bad choices, which separated us from Him. No amount of good things we do can wipe the slate clean. So God sent Jesus, His son, to take on human form, to live with us, teach us and then to die to pay the price for all of our bad choices. 

GROWING IN FAITH

Why should I be part of a Bible Study group? Excerpted from GotQuestions.org

Really understand what the Bible is saying. Reading the Bible on your own is valuable. But it's a very rich text, and often you can miss important insights. A Bible Study group, where scripture is read together aloud and then discussed, with references to other parts of the Bible and historical insights, can help everyone in the group learn from each other and gain insights and how to apply it to your life.

Jesus did it this way. Small group study is so effective that Jesus used it to train his apostles (Luke 6:12–16; Mark 4:34).

Friendship and fellowship. A group Bible study can be a place to celebrate life's victories, get prayer support, be encouraged in tough times, and keep ourselves accountable in our personal growth. Group Bible studies offer a structured time to focus on topics that address our needs or interests. They offer a way to help carry us



from Sunday to Sunday and a safe place to work out the challenges we face.

God wants us to do this. God designed us to need Him, and to need each other. His word to us is to reach out and love one another. Colossians 3:16 says we should allow "the message of Christ to dwell among you richly as you teach and admonish one another with all wisdom through psalms, hymns, and songs from the Spirit, singing to God with gratitude in your hearts." What better place for that than in a small Bible study group?

THE POWER OF PRAYER

How Shall I Pray? Excerpted from GotQuestions.org

Far too often, prayer is viewed as a "magic formula." Some believe that if we do not say exactly the right things, or pray in the right position, God will not hear and answer our prayer. This is completely unbiblical. God does not answer our prayers based on when we pray, where we are, what position our body is in, or in what order we word our prayers.

We are told in 1 John 5:14-15 to have confidence when we come to God in prayer, knowing He hears us and will grant whatever we ask as long as it is in His will. Similarly, John 14:13-14 declares, "And I will do whatever you ask in my name, so that the Son may bring glory to the Father. You may ask me for anything in my name, and I will do it."



According to these and many other Scriptures, God answers prayer requests based on whether they are asked according to His will and in the name of Jesus (to bring glory to Jesus).

So, what is the proper way to pray? Philippians 4:6-7 tells us to pray without being anxious, to pray about everything, and to pray with thankful hearts. God will answer all such prayers with the gift of His peace in our hearts. The proper way to pray is to pour out our hearts to God, being honest and open with God, as He already knows us better than we know ourselves. We are to present our requests to God, keeping in mind that God knows what is best and will not grant a request that is not His will for us. We are to express our love, gratitude, and worship to God in prayer without worrying about having just the right words to say. God is more interested in the content of our hearts than the eloquence of our words.

Mat Makers benefit the homeless

SUMC has been the home base for the Mat Makers for the Homeless since 2018 under the guidance of Pastor Sue Ritts. The group has been collects plastic grocery bags and makes crocheted sleeping mats through a process that includes folding, cutting into strips, looping, plarning (balling) and finally, crocheting. The finished mats take some time to make but have a unique look due to the talented crocheted colorful patterns.

The Mat Maker group project is a charity, open to everyone. The Mat Makers have been meeting at SUMC on the first Monday of the month from 12:30-2 pm. The group is currently on a schedule break during December and January but plans to start the sessions up again the first of February 2024. Many of our members continue to work at home on the phase of the process they prefer. No idle hands with this charity project!

It is estimated that we have delivered 300 finished mats to homeless shelters in northeastern Ohio since the conception of our Mat Makers for the Homeless

The biggest event for the Mat Makers has been participating in the Kent State University Alumni "Flashes Give Back Week," which is held annually in April.



Next year's event will be Saturday, April 20, 2024 10:30-1pm in the Church Fellowship Hall. Grab your plastic bags, bring your scissors, or your extra-large crochet hook, and join us at our regular sessions in February and the Spring, and be sure to mark the date April 20 on your 2024 calendar.


But unlike many other young athletes who find success and glorify themselves, Stroud starts every interview by praising God and all that He has done for him in his life.
